

IN THE MATTER OF ENACTING AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VENDORS  
FROM CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN AN AREA FIFTY FEET FROM THE CENTER  
LINE OF THE BOGUE CHITTO WATER PARK ROAD

WHEREAS, it appears unto the Board of Supervisors that tube and canoe vendors have been conducting business on the edge and shoulder and in the Bogue Chitto Water Park Road and that such constitutes a safety hazard for motorist attempting to use the said Bogue Chitto Water Park Road, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it would be to the best interest of the citizens of Pike County, Mississippi, for the Board of Supervisors to enact an ordinance prohibiting any type of vendors from conducting business within an area of fifty feet on either side of the center line of said Bogue Chitto Water Park Road, to include the loading and unloading of canoes.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion duly made by Supervisor Jesse Hall, seconded by Supervisor Doyle Foman, and unanimously carried, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that it shall be unlawful for vendors to conduct business within an area of fifty feet from either side of the center line of the Bogue Chitto Water Park Road to include the loading and unloading of tubes or canoes by said vendors or their customers or other persons, and that upon conviction, a violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by thirty days in the County Jail, or by both. It is further ordered that the Clerk of this Board publish notice of this ordinance in the manner and for the time required by law.
