

BANNING ALCOHOL ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE
BOGUE CHITTO RIVER AND TOPISAW CREEK IN PIKE COUNTY, MS

Supervisor Tazwell Bowsky left the Board meeting because of other business around 10:20 a.m. Mr. Bowsky turned the meeting over to Board Vice-President Chuck Lambert.

WHEREAS, following a report from the Sheriff's Department concerning recent activity on the Bogue Chitto River and Topisaw Creek; and

WHEREAS, a motion was made by Supervisor Venton Ray Adams to pass the proposed alcohol ordinance prohibiting the possession and consumption of alcohol of any kind on certain portions of the Bogue Chitto River and Topisaw Creek in Pike County, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, said motion was seconded by Supervisor Gary Honea. The three supervisors present Gary Honea, Venton Adams and Chuck Lambert voted for the alcohol ban.

Supervisor Lexie Elmore arrived at the meeting around 10:45 a.m. (shortly after the vote was taken). With discussion of the ban still ongoing, a unanimous consent was requested by presiding officer, Vice-President Chuck Lambert for Supervisor Lexie Elmore to cast a vote on the alcohol ban. Unanimous consent was granted, and Supervisor Elmore voted for the ban.

At that time unanimous consent was requested again by presiding officer Vice President Chuck Lambert for Supervisor Tazwell Bowsky to cast a vote on the alcohol ban. Unanimous consent was granted and Supervisor Bowsky voted for the ban.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pike County Board of Supervisors approves adopting an ordinance prohibiting the possession and consumption of alcohol of any

kind on certain portions of the Bogue Chitto River and
Topisaw Creek in Pike County, Mississippi.
